

## Hungary – University of Pécs

### I – Preparation

The person interviewed was second year student on Human Relations Consultant Program at the Faculty of Education, Pedagogy and Regional Development, University of Pécs. The interview took place on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The students interviewed is a 24 years old man from Syria, who he has been living in Hungary for a year.

### II - Awareness

He I was aware of his skills and competencies. He said he had some invention ideas that might be helpful for the society and that can be developed in Hungary. He had a clear idea in my mind that he needed to learn and find a job in future.

He decided to study HR in Hungary because he wanted to gain new experience because he had never been abroad and in Europe. He believes Hungary it is a cheap country for students and peaceful and for studying HR specifically. He worked for HR recruiter for six month and because of his background in management, he also likes since long time ago to be a recruiter.

When the Syrian war broke out, he was in the Emirates in the city in Sharjah and he could not go back to Syria.

He thinks the area he was in does not provide many working opportunities, so maybe when I finish my studies I would search for new job in new area. He was given the full help and information by professors and friends.

### III - Starting up

He was searching for opportunity abroad and he found this opportunity through a website. He has applied and got accepted by filling a form and it included personal data and work experience, then conducted Skype interview with a professor explaining how he could be helpful if he came over to Hungary and that he had ideas he would give to this country.

#### **IV – Documentation and support**

There was no guidance. Actually it was easy because he got all the documents and he had to provide them to the organization and that was all. The main focus was being honest in his answer because it helped them see the reflection of myself to provide education or hobbies that he liked to do or creative ideas that were in his mind that will ensure them to see him better than other candidates. He filled in an online application with info about education and work experience and personal CV. It was not hard, he prepared himself on what he should say in the interview and not get out of the topic and making the professor interested in what he said, explaining that he was trying to work hard and is good person to be chosen to study and be part of the Hungarian community. All of the application and information was listed so it was smooth and easy to provide information from first to last step.

#### **V - Assessment**

He thought about the questions that might be asked and he had the answers prepared. He I didn't know the questions but had some in my mind that they might be asked. It was a skype interview based on questions, around fifteen to thirty minutes and it was once. The interviewer was supportive to him and even after skype interview he was helpful and he helped him go back to the city. He knew it will be skype interview.

#### **VI – Impact**

The person interviewed said he had the opportunity to study in Hungary in KPVK. He is not yet a Graduate. He is happy because it is a free country to express my opinion and to study what I want and work whatever I want.

#### **VII - Impact on the longer term**

He believes he has taken some steps to prepare himself to living in the new country, he also started learning more about business and HR counselling from psychological perspective and business perspective.
